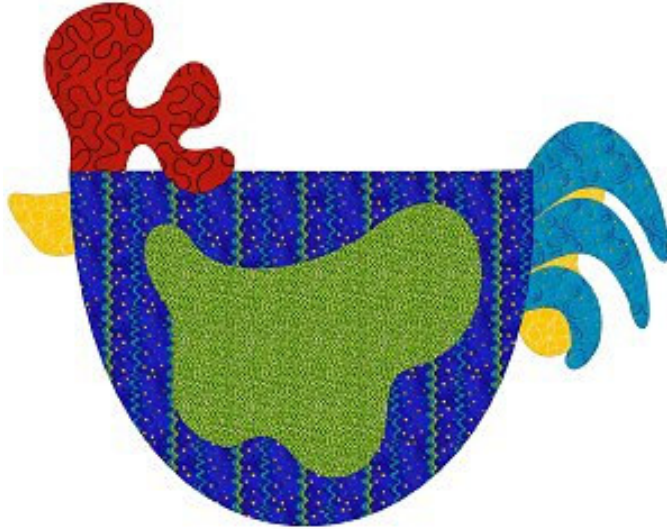


# Chuckie Doodle Doo

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Originally released 1999



## Materials Needed

- Body – 1 yard or 4 fat quarters
- Wings – ½ yard or 2 fat quarters
- Tail, Comb, Beak, & Feathers – scraps
- Webbing for strap
- 2 yards of Batting
- Buttons for eyes
- Zipper optional

Don't forget your sense of humor, this guy is a Breeze to make, and a hoot to wear!

- D - base of tail – cut 2 fabric
- E – feather – cut 4 fabric
- F - feather – cut 4 fabric
- G – feather – cut 4 fabric
- H – Body – cut 4 fabric
- I – Wing pocket – cut 4 fabric

There are some large template pieces in this packet. You will need to lay the pages out and tape them together before cutting out your templates.

Cut out or trace around the pattern pieces and let's get started. Take your yard of body fabric and fold it in half, then half again. So now you basically have it folded like 4 fat quarters. If your using fat quarters, make sure they are not all right side up!! **This is very important. You will be cutting the patterns both right and wrong side, all at once.** Pin the patterns to your fabrics, and cut around them. Repeat this with all the rest of the body parts.

So now you have all the parts cut out...what's next? Lay out your batting. Take your body parts two pieces of fabric at a time, with the right sides of the fabric together. Arrange them on the batting and pin them down. Now cut generously around them to separate the different parts.

Okay, here we are with a stack of body parts pinned to batting! With a normal straight stitch sew around the parts, making sure to leave a large enough opening to turn them right side out. Take your time and leave a ¼ inch seam allowance.

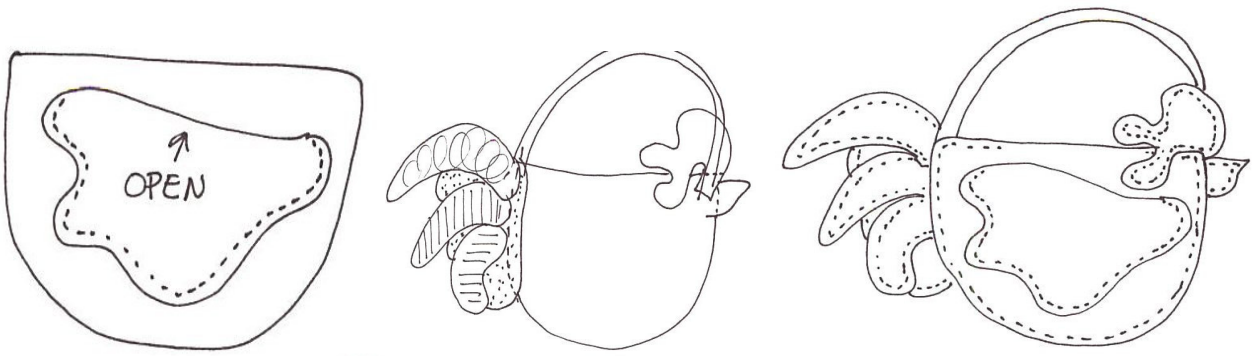
There!! You made parts! Told you this was easy. Time to flip all these babies right side out. The feathers are a bit tricky, but I know you can do it. This is where it gets fun! Machine quilt everything. Anyway you wish. I went around and around in a circular motion on mine, kind of echoing the shape of each part. While you're doing this, be sure to catch and close the opening you used to turn them right side out.

Center and sew wing pockets to the body sections. Only sew around the outer edges, not across the top. You do want to be able to use the pocket!!

We are just breezing right along here. Ready to put together the tail? Gotta love that tail! Look at the diagram and sew one of each feather to one side of the tail. Now flip it over and sew the feathers to the other side.

Take a body part and lay it pocket side down. Pin the tail section, combs, and beak in place, then stitch down. Using a scant  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch seam allowance. Sew down the webbing you're going to use for straps. If you plan on using a zipper, sew that baby on now too.

Now carefully pin the remaining body section to the top of what you have done. Sew from the edge of the webbing around the body to the other end of the webbing. Use another  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch seam allowance. You are nearly done!!! Pick out the perfect buttons for eyes and sew those babies down. There! You have now made a Chuckle Doodle Doo 😊



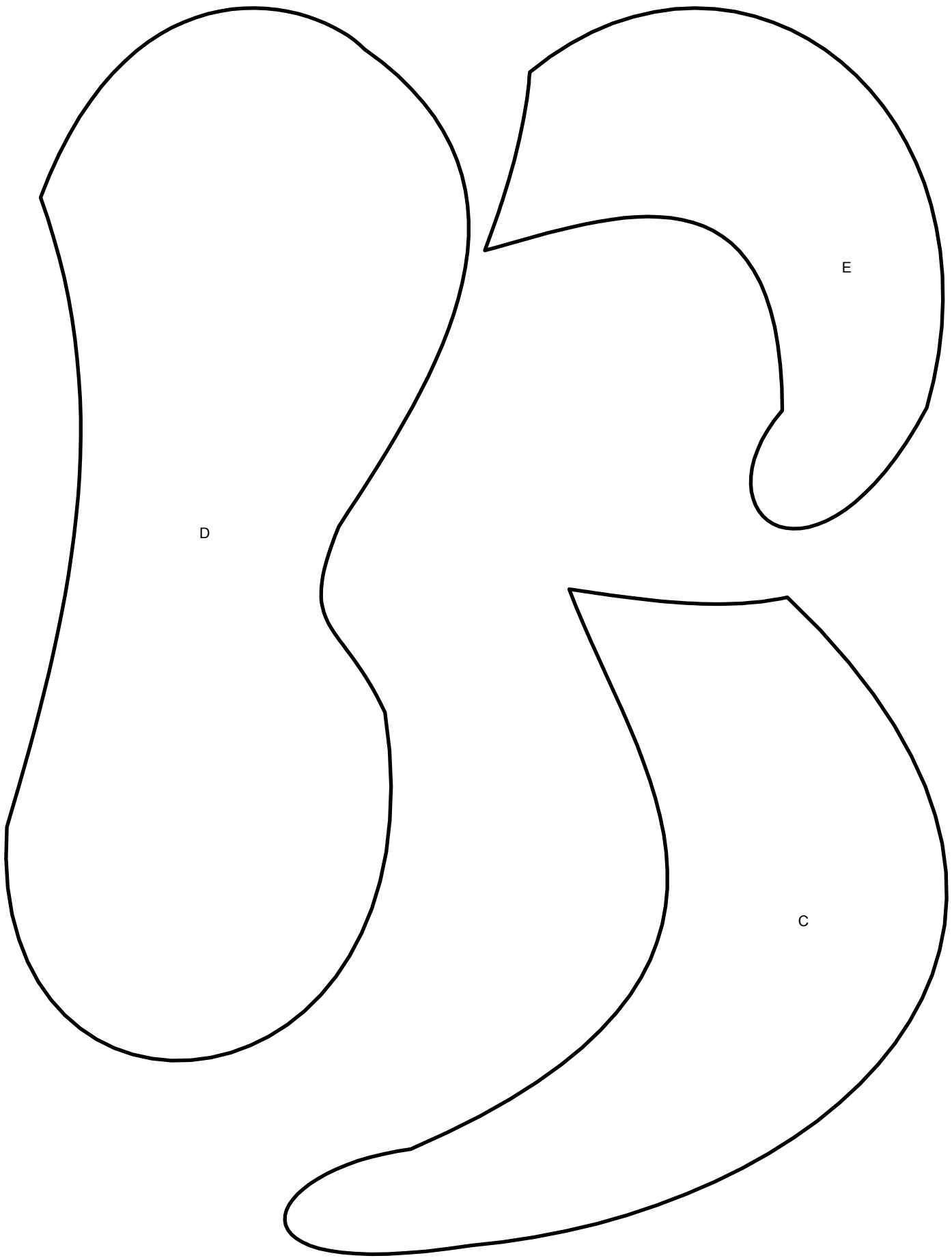
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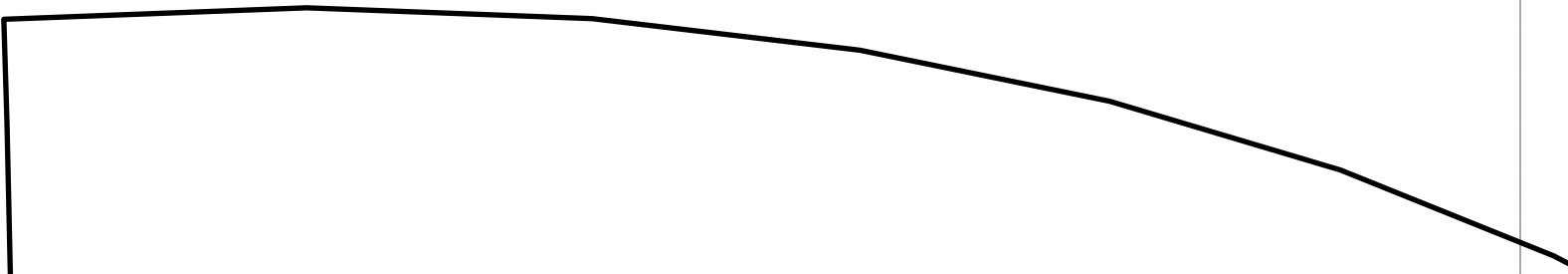
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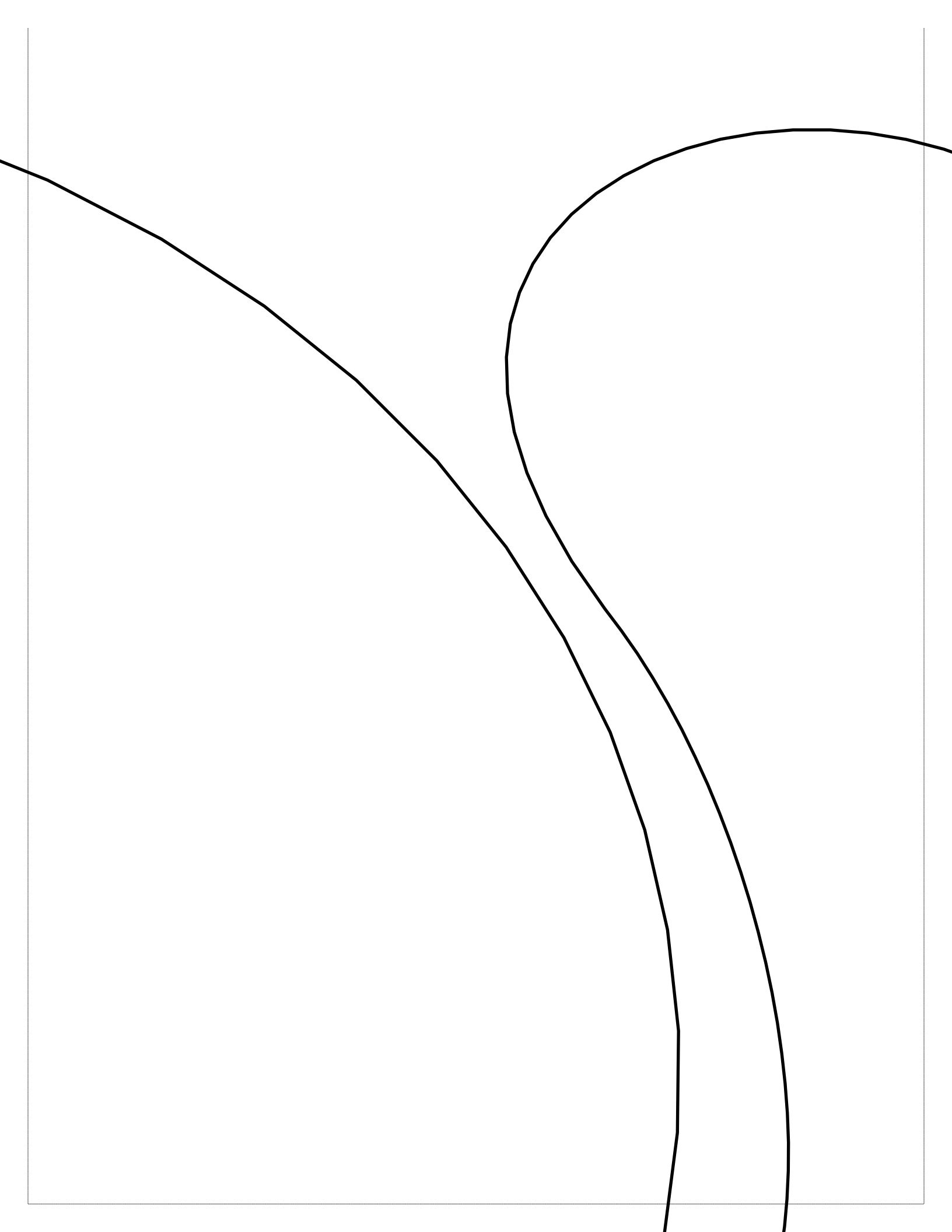


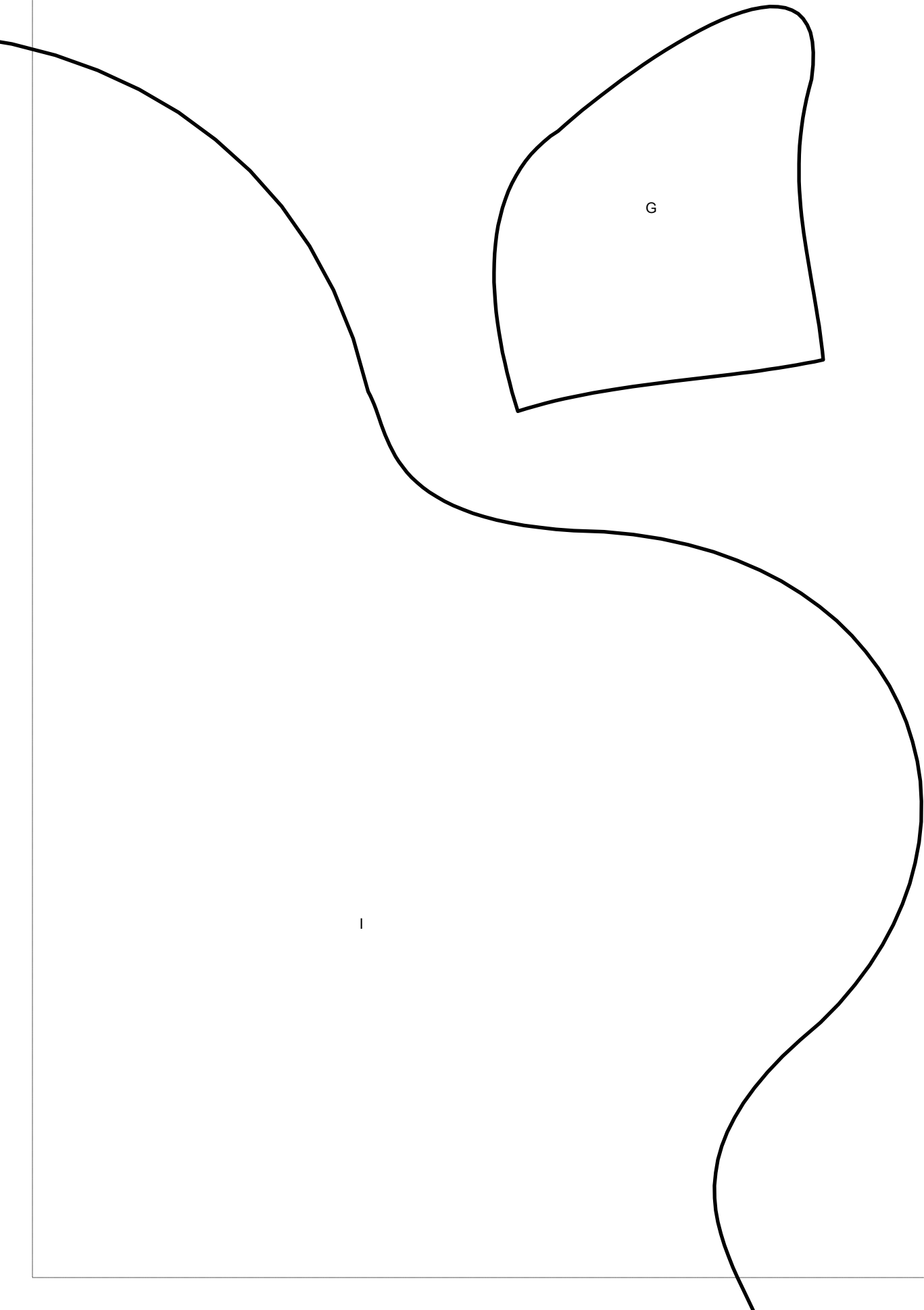
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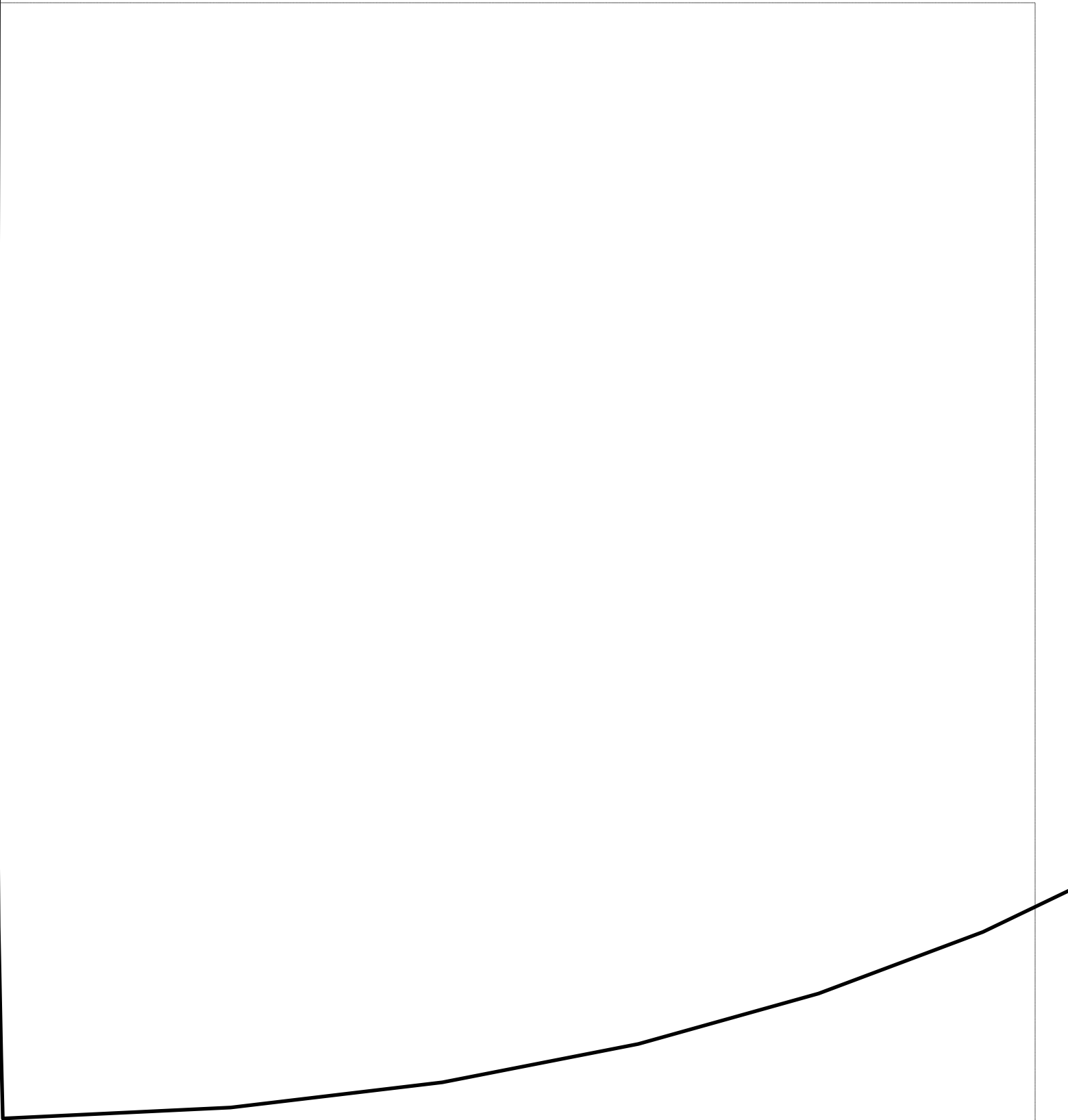
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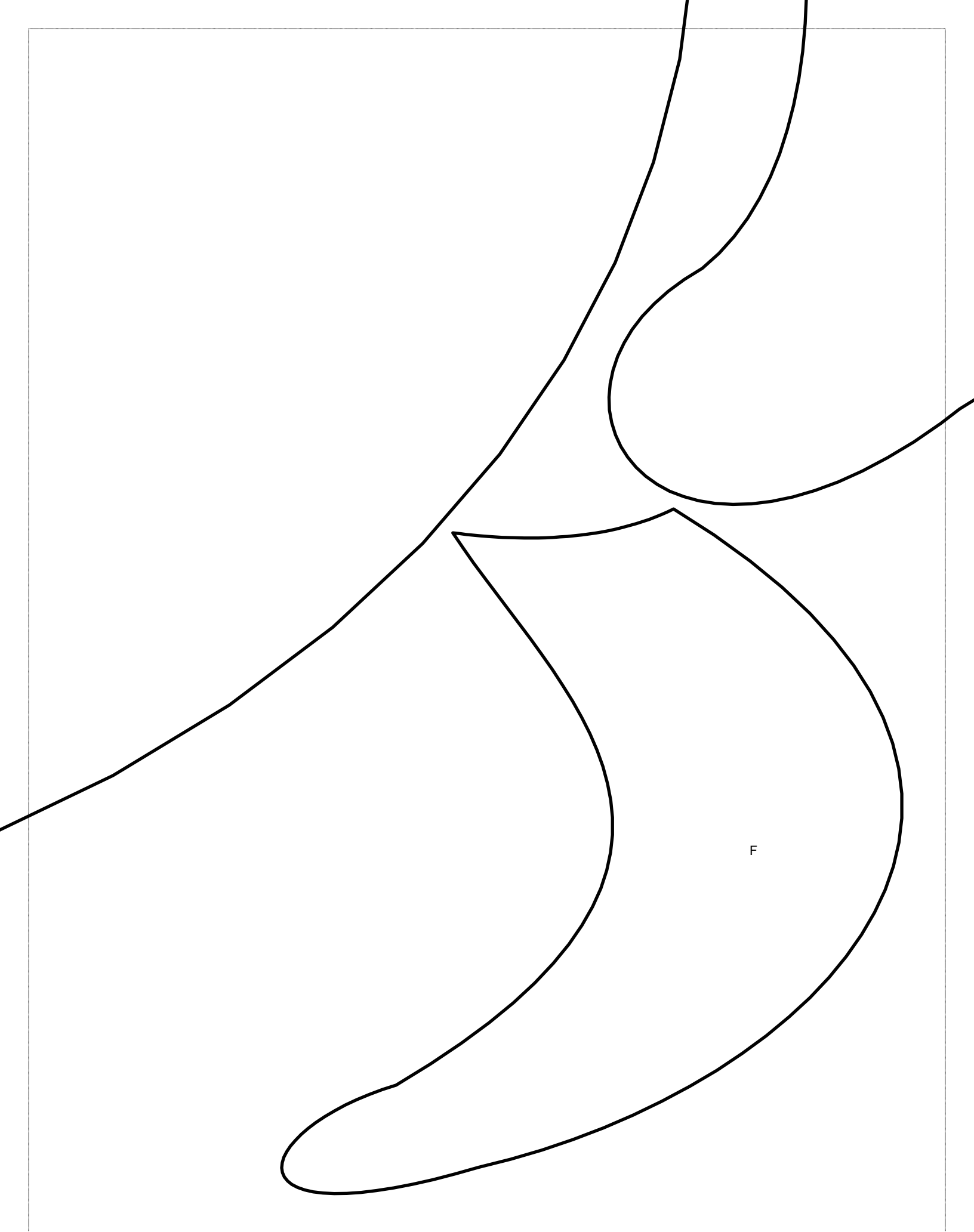
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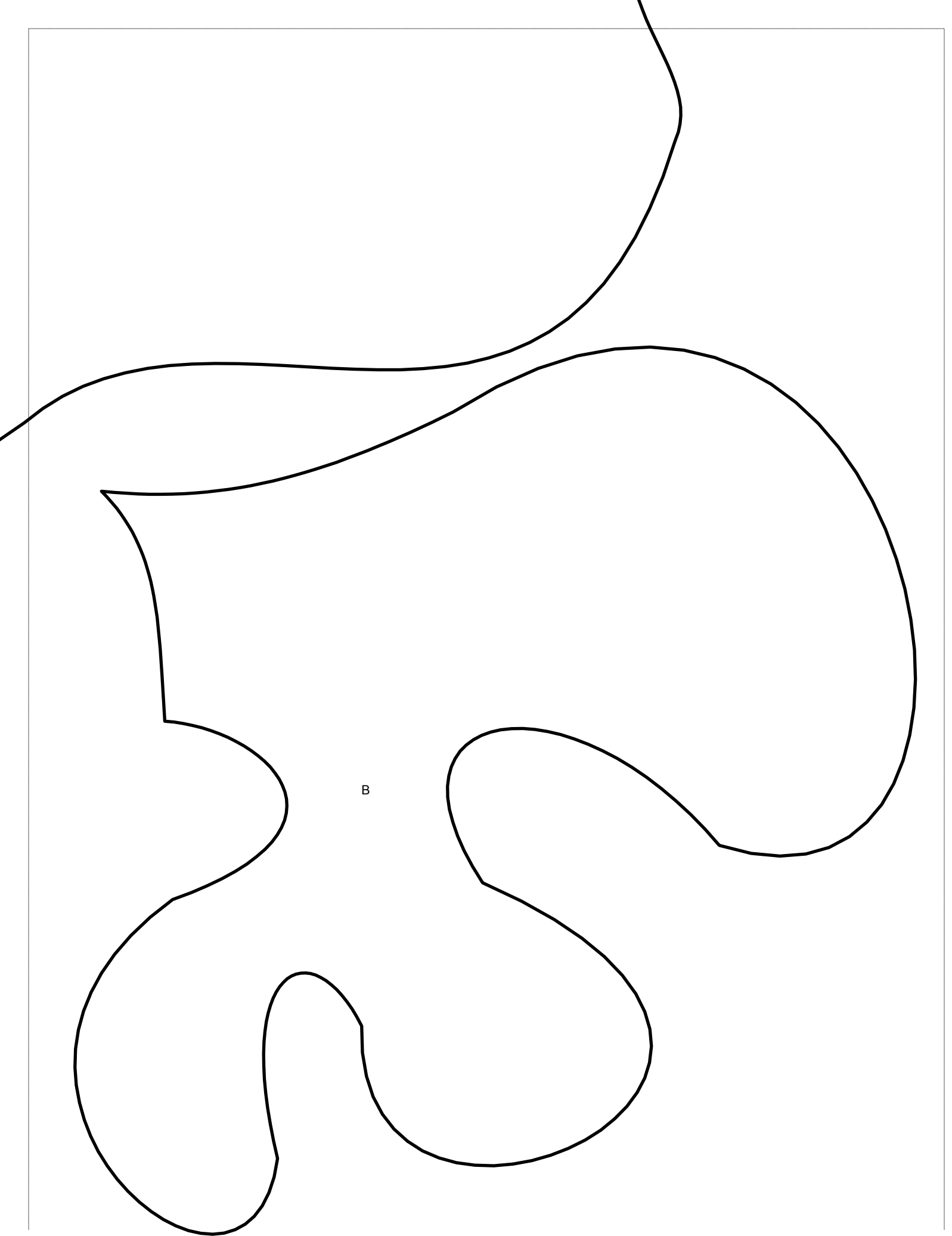












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
